

### Douglas E. Stewart

Douglas serves as Vice President, General Counsel and Chief Compliance Officer of Vantage Drilling International, an international offshore drilling company serving major, national, and independent oil and gas companies, where he directs the Company's legal and compliance groups. Douglas joined Vantage in June 2016 to effectuate an operational, financial, and legal turnaround. As part of this effort, Vantage successfully prevailed in a contract dispute with an arbitration award in excess of \$622 million, favorably resolved an array of inherited disputes, and revamped and modernized the Company's compliance program. Douglas was also named to *The Legal 500 GC Powerlist United States 2019*.

Prior to Vantage, Douglas served for nine years as the Executive Vice President, General Counsel and Secretary of Stallion Oilfield Holdings, Inc., an oilfield service company that provides comprehensive wellsite support services and production & logistics services to exploration and production companies and drilling contractors throughout the United States. During his tenure at Stallion, the company raised \$850 million in capital and financings, paying more than approximately \$300 million in dividends to stockholders and executing on more than \$300 million in acquisitions.

Douglas's experience includes work at Occidental Development Company, a subsidiary of Occidental Petroleum Corporation, where he served in the international business development group. Prior to joining Occidental, he practiced corporate finance and securities law, specializing in private equity and mergers and acquisitions, at Vinson & Elkins LLP, during which he was named a "*Texas Rising Star*" in mergers and acquisitions.

Douglas received his Bachelor of Arts degree *cum laude* in Economics and International Studies from Trinity University and his J.D. *with honors* from the University of Texas School of Law. Douglas also studied at Queen Mary & Westfield College of Law, London, England, Instituto Tecnológico de Estudios Superiores de Monterrey, Monterrey, N.L.
